
# TRAFFIC AND SAFETY COMMITTEE FOREST GROVE PAC

Please find below a map of the east parking area showing our designated pick-up and drop off zone (Kiss & Drop Zone), public parking area and pedestrian walk ways.

- Kiss & Drop Zone Pick up & Drop off ONLY
- Public Parking Zones
- Pedestrian Access west of cement barriers
- Arrows Traffic flow One-Way traffic only



## PICK-UP/DROP-OFF AND PARKING POLICIES

Please review our policies regarding this area:

## 1. Advantage of the "Kiss & Drop" zone:

• Students are dropped off at the safest location at the school.

#### 2. Can I park in the "Kiss & Drop" zone?

• No, parking in the Kiss & Drop zone prevents the area from being used safely and reduces the number of cars that can use the Kiss & Drop zone.

## 3. Can I drop-off my child anywhere in the "Kiss & Drop" zone?

 No, please pull into the Kiss & Drop zone as far as possible before dropping off your child. This allows the maximum number of vehicles access to the curb, which is the safest place to drop-off your child.

#### 4. How should students exit vehicles?

• The safest place for your child to exit your vehicle is the passenger side. The east parking area is wide enough for cars to pass each other creating a dangerous situation for pedestrians.

#### 5. Can I park and drop my kids on the west parking lot?

• No, this parking lot is for teachers, staff of Forest Grove, staff of Burnaby Parks & Rec and the Pre-School.

#### 6. How do I access the school with a stroller on the east side?

A cement barrier has been installed on the exit driveway of the east parking lot.
 When walking up the driveway, please make sure the cement barriers are on your right-hand side.

#### 7. Pick up at the end of the day:

• The loading process takes significantly longer. Please do not park in the Kiss & Drop zone and exit your vehicle to pick up your child from the classroom. You must stay in the vehicle and wait. If you prefer to park, please use the designated zones. We recognize that at times, this is terribly inconvenient; however, it is our reality and would ask that you respect these parking restrictions.
