PRINCIPAL'S REPORT-JUNE 2021

Recent Events:

- 1. New tech for Forest Grove
 - a. To start this year, we received 59 student laptops which were allocated throughout the school for student use in classrooms
 - b. Starting in September 2021, we will be getting an extra 21 student laptops along with 40 student iPads and 4 staff CPU towers.
 - c. The tables and previous "lab" in the library will be removed and the overall 80 student laptops will be housed partially in classrooms for student use and in laptop carts for classrooms to sign out.
- 2. Ministry of Education Announcement for Sept. 2021
 - a. A lot of information was released today... I haven't even had a chance to read it yet, but highlights so far are:
 - i. As part of the return to school in September 2021, students can expect to learn in classrooms full time. Similar to any other school year, Burnaby Online learning will remain available as an option for students.
 - ii. Based on guidance from the Office of the Provincial Health Officer, students will **no longer be grouped into cohorts** this September.
 - iii. It is anticipated that the **restrictions on gatherings**, **extracurricular activities and sports will no longer be required** when the new school year begins.
 - iv. Guidance on **wearing masks in a school setting will be confirmed later** this summer and in alignment with provincial direction for the fall and winter.
 - v. Students will continue to be required to complete **daily health** checks, stay home when feeling sick and practice diligent hand hygiene.

 - a. Wednesday afternoon of next week (June 23) we will holding a special, but messy, event for our grade 7's.
- 2. Planning for next year
 - a. Just a reminder that an email went out to all families allowing for input on student needs and providing the school with information when considering class placements for next year.
 - b. We are starting our class loading procedures next week...knowing that things may change due to fluctuations in our enrollment number (currently, we are up slightly, but not significantly)
